(b) Black Cat Speed Awareness Monitor:

- Approximately 2% of the vehicles traveling on McGuire Street, are traveling over the posted speed limit of 50 km/h. Approximately 0% of the vehicles are traveling over 55 km/h and approximately 0% are traveling over 60 km/h.
- Approximately 14% of the vehicles traveling on Golf Course Road, are traveling over the posted speed limit of 60 km/h. Approximately 8% of the vehicles are traveling over 65 km/h and approximately 4% are traveling over 70 km/h.
- Approximately 1% of the vehicles traveling on Pinegrove Crescent, are traveling over the posted speed limit of 50 km/h. Approximately 1% of the vehicles are traveling over 55 km/h and approximately 0% are traveling over 60 km/h.
