

Rules of Conduct for Public Ice Skating Petawawa Civic Centre

1. No food or drink on the ice surface.
2. No horseplay or games.
3. No figure skating maneuvers.
4. No erratic or excessive speeds.
5. No balls, pucks, chairs, strollers, sticks or any other items which might interfere with the safety of another skater while on the ice surface.
6. No headsets, cell phones or hand held electronic devices are to be used while skating.
7. No carrying of children permitted.
8. No sitting on the boards.
9. Skate with the direction of all skaters.
10. Listen and adhere to the skate monitors at all times. All participants must be wearing skates while on the ice surface.
11. Consider the use of a helmet as they are strongly recommended.
