PUBLIC MEETING

1. Zoning By-law Amendment (from “Rural” to “Residential One”) – Brian Eichstaedt, Part of Lot 12, Concession 6, Murphy Road, in the Town of Petawawa

The Public Meeting was opened by the Mayor at 6:31 p.m. Karen Cronier, Director of Planning and Development, advised that the Notice of Public Meeting had been

provided as required under the Planning Act. No written submissions were received regarding the application.

Ms. Cronier explained the purpose and effect of the amendment is to rezone the severed lands in Consent Applications B108/19(1) and B109/19(2) from Rural (RU) to Residential One (R1) as a condition of consent to permit the severance of two new residential lots. All other provisions of the Zoning By-law shall apply.

Mayor Sweet asked to hear comments from members of the public. No one from the public came forward to speak for or against the application.

Ms. Cronier then explained the appeal process to those present.

1. ADMIN-25-2020 – Joint Community Safety and Well-Being Plan and Advisory Committee

- (9) **WHEREAS** the province of Ontario has enacted legislation which now forms part of the *Police Services Act* of Ontario, requiring all municipalities to develop a Community Safety and Well-Being Plan and publish the completed plan on the internet within 30 days after adopting it;

AND WHEREAS the legislation permits municipalities to work together to complete a joint Community Safety and Well-Being Plan that focuses on emergency response, risk mitigation, prevention, and social development as the pillars of community safety and well-being planning;

AND WHEREAS there have been discussions and a consensus has been reached between the municipalities of the Town of Petawawa, City of Pembroke, Town of Laurentian Hills, Town of Deep River, Township of Laurentian Valley, Township of Whitewater Region, United Townships of Head, Clara & Maria, and a portion of the Township of Admaston/Bromley, to develop a joint Community Safety and Well-Being Plan;

AND WHEREAS the City of Pembroke has obtained a provincial grant and hired a qualified coordinator to guide the municipalities through the plan development process;

AND WHEREAS an advisory committee has been established with broad representation from the participating municipalities including municipal employees and members of the respective councils as well as representatives of local health, human and justice services;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Petawawa formally agrees to participating in the development of a joint Community Safety and Well-Being Plan guided by the advisory committee which will develop and present a joint plan for the review and ultimate final approval by each participating council.


