Fire Department

1. Monthly Report – December 2024

Craig Proulx, Acting Fire Chief, provided an overview of the monthly report, referencing incident responses, fire prevention activities, residential smoke alarm and open-air permits, platoon training focusing on donning and doffing of ice rescue equipment, the use of multi-gas detectors, presumptive legislation training on cancer prevention and post incident decontamination training. Acting Fire Chief Proulx reported that the Emergency Preparedness Control Group annual training was conducted on December 6, 2024, and that the compliance report was successfully submitted to Emergency Management Ontario by the December 31, 2024 deadline. Acting Fire Chief Proulx also reported on the successful grant application under the Town's Fire Protection Grant which was approved for \$16,460.90 to support the purchase of four additional sets of bunker gear for our firefighters.
