Purpose of the Position

To provide general maintenance of parks, storm ponds, and roadsides, within the Town of Petawawa for the safety and convenience of the public.

Major Responsibilities

Program/Service

- responsible for conducting general maintenance of parks, storm ponds, roadsides and Public Works operations, such as:
 - summer maintenance, including use of lawnmowers, whipper snippers, fueling, and minor maintenance of equipment
 - cleaning and removing of garbage and debris in parks
 - washing vehicles and general clean-up of Public Works garage
 - other duties as may be assigned, from time to time

The above description reflects the general duties necessary to describe the principal function of the job identified and shall not be construed to be all of the work requirements that may be inherent in this classification.

Human Resources

• not responsible for supervising or directing the work of others

Financial Resources

• not responsible for the preparation of budgets or acquisition of funds

Material Resources

- carry out work assignments using a variety of power and hand tools, and operate vehicles
- responsible for the safe and effective use of all equipment
- maintain equipment, vehicles and tools in a safe operating condition
- follow acceptable maintenance and servicing schedules

- ability to operate a variety of machinery and equipment safely and efficiently

 - maintain a positive public image
