2. FD-05-2024 – Proposed Amendments to By-law 1309/19, being a by-law to adopt an Emergency Management Program and Emergency Response Plan and to meet other requirements under the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act

Craig Proulx provided an overview of the report.

That Council amends Sections 6, 7, and 8 of By-law 1309/19, being a by-law to adopt an Emergency Management Program and Emergency Response Plan and to meet other requirements under the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act, as follows:

- 6. The **Fire Chief** is hereby appointed as the primary community emergency management coordinator (the "CEMC") responsible for the emergency management program for the Town including maintenance of the Plan, training, exercises, public education and such other duties and responsibilities as outlined in the *Act* and *Reg*.
- 7. The **Director of Legislative Services/Clerk** is hereby appointed as alternate CEMC to act in place of the primary CEMC in their absence.
- 8. The person from time to time holding the following positions in the municipality, or their designates, shall be members of the Emergency Management Program Committee:
 - a. **Fire Chief**/CEMC;
 - b. **Director of Legislative Services/Clerk/**Alternate CEMC;
 - c. **Deputy Fire Chief**;
 - d. **A Firefighter**, appointed by the Fire Chief; and
 - e. **A member of Council**, appointed by resolution of Council.
