*Note: all County and Education Taxes are collected by the Town and remitted on your behalf. These amounts are not included in, or eligible for, the Town's budget.

How are property taxes calculated?

Property taxes are dependent on multiple factors not limited to: your property value, your municipality's budget, your upper tier's (County) budget, and provincial legislation. Please contact the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC) should you believe there to be any issues with your assessment or property owner information.

What methods of payment are accepted?

Online Banking – This payment option is available with most major banks. Use your 19 digit roll number (without decimals or spaces) as your account number and search "Petawawa" to locate account name e.g., "Petawawa, Town of – Tax Acct."

By Mail – Send your payment to the Town of Petawawa, 1111 Victoria Street, Petawawa, ON K8H 2E6. Include either the stub from your tax bill or a note with payment information that includes your Roll Number. **Bank/Financial Institution** – Contact your financial institution for further information. Bank service charges may apply.

In Person – The Town Office is located at 1111 Victoria Street, Petawawa, and is open from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday except statutory holidays. We accept payment by cash, cheque (made payable to the Town of Petawawa), or debit.

Night Deposit Box – A night deposit box is located at the Council Chamber entrance of the Town Office. Please ensure that your cheque and payment information are placed in a sealed envelope. Please do not place cash in this box.

Post-Dated Cheques – Post-dated cheques can be dropped off at the Town Office in person, mailed, or deposited in the night deposit box.

NOTE: The Town of Petawawa does not offer Pre-authorized Payment Plans.

How to Read Your Final Tax Bill

Below is a sample bill with sections highlighted in <u>red text</u> to explain the details of your Final Tax Bill. Key information includes:

- <u>Two installments.</u> Your total amount due is split into two installments, each with its own due date. Interest and penalties are charges on past due balances at 1.25% per month. A reminder for the Second Installment is not sent.
- <u>County and Education Taxes.</u> These taxes are collected by the Town and remitted on your behalf. These amounts are not included, or eligible, in the Town's budget.
